White Office Building Tehran, Iran

This office and retail building combines a curtain wall and a pattern of white horizontal aluminum louvers to create a facade that stands out from its surroundings.

White Office Building is a project totaling 16,150 square feet (1,500 square meters) that sits along one of the busiest streets of Shahrak-e Gharb, a planned town located in the northwestern part of Tehran, Iran.

The office complex, comprised of five levels of open workspace and a double-height retail front, features an iconic double-skin glazed facade equipped with white aluminum louvers arranged horizontally. At every level, louvers are interrupted along their length to form an opening, bringing in natural ventilation, and in front of which an automatic irrigation system is installed.
